# Bonpoint



## 1 – PREPARE THE MATERIAL LIST

- Print B-templates and sheet with Bonpoint logo
- Take 4 large wooden skewer picks
- 1 cardboard white sheet
- 1 tree branch or foliage
- 1 rule
- 1 tube of glue
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 pen or pencil black



## 2 – PREPARE THE ELEMENTS IN THE RIGHT FORMATS

- Cut out the rectangle and the label from sheet "Template B". Position the cut elements on the cardboard sheet and trace the outlines.



Tip: For the rectangle, you can use a ruler for a straighter line.

- Cut out the rectangle and the label from the cardboard sheet
- Reserve the label on the side.



## 3 – GLUE YOUR BRANCH

- Glue your branch in your sheet.



Tip : for a better rendering, you can put your branch between 2 sheets of a large book 24 hours before the workshop in order to flatten it.





## 4 – LET YOUR BRANCH DRY

- Let your branch dry so that any excess glue can dry without leaving a trace.



## 5 – CREATE A WOODEN FRAME

- Use the Bonpoint sheet.
- Position the skewers on the dotted frame.
- Cut the baguettes to the correct size.
- Apply glue on the dotted lines and position the previously cut strips.
- Leave to dry for 30 min



Tip: Press hard to improve the adhesion of the wood to the sheet



## 6 – PUT TOGETHER

- Glue the leaf with your branch in the center of your frame.
- Indicate in pencil the name of your branch on the label.
- Stick the label on the wooden stick
