

HERBARIUM: TRANSFERRED FLOWERS








1 - MATERIAL PREPARATION

- Print Templates A and B and the sheet with the Bonpoint logo.
- 1 cardboard white sheet
- 1 carton (or inside a cereal box)
- Petals of FRESH and COLOURFUL flowers
- 1 ruler / 1 flat bottom glass
- 1 tube of glue/ 1 sheet of paper towel
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 pen or pencil black



2 - CUTTING TEMPLATE

- Cut out the rectangle from Template A.
- Cut out the rectangle and the label from Template B sheet.



3 - CUTTING ELEMENTS IN THE RIGHT SIZES

- Position the rectangle of Template A on the cardboard, as well as the Label template.
- Position the rectangle from Template B on the cardboard sheet.
- Cut out the traced elements.



Tip: For the rectangle, you can use a ruler for a straighter line.











4 – POSITION OF PETALS

• On the cardboard sheet, position the petals to give them the desired shape.



5 – POSITION OF PAPER TOWEL

 Cover the petals with the paper towel most delicately to avoid moving the petals just placed.



6 – COLOR TRANSFER

- Using the flat bottom glass (or any other heavy instrument with a flat surface), tap on the area where the petals are located.
- => the absorbent paper must tint slightly at the marking areas.







7 - ADMIRE YOUR TRANSFER

- Lift the absorbent paper and check that the transfer has been completed.
- If the shape isn't right for you, you can readjust by replacing the paper towel and tapping the unmarked spaces again.



8 - ASSEMBLY AND DRAWING

- Draw the stem of your flower adding leaves.
- Write the name of the flower on the label.
- Glue the cardboard onto the Bonpoint sheet, then the centered cardboard sheet.
- Finally position the label under the cardboard frame.
